

## Small Group Leader Job Description

### Purpose:

- The purpose of a SGL is to be committed to fulfilling the Great Commission given by Jesus, to disciple all Nations. (Matt. 28:20)
- The purpose of a SGL is to do Discipleship in a relational context, where the maturing believer helps to grow members of the small group, just as Jesus disciplined the Twelve.
- The purpose of a SGL is to follow the instructions of Paul to Timothy - "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others." 2 Timothy 2:2. In this way, we perpetuate the continuous development of disciples making disciples on the college campus.
- Thus, a SGL is the primary leader in Chi Alpha who is trained and set apart to disciple fellow students in a small group within the Chi Alpha ministry.

### Responsibilities:

- Daily Devotion to Jesus
- Every Conversation leads to Jesus
- Hang out with your Small Group outside of Small Group
- Honor people to other people
- Delegate Responsibility to Create Maturity
- Have the Grit to keep going

### Requirements:

- Must consistently attend a UNL XA Small Group for at least 1 semester before leading.
- Must attend Discipleship Training Class (DTC) and be approved by the Chi Alpha staff to lead a small group the following semester.
- Must interview each Spring to serve as a leader for the next school year.
- Must adhere to the Chi Alpha Student Leadership Conduct Agreement, Vision, Mission and Core Beliefs.

### Commitments:

- Do the work of Discipleship
  - Time: approx. 8-11 hours a week
    - To adequately prepare for and lead your Small Group weekly (3 hrs)
    - To lovingly and consistently disciple each of the friends in your Small Group one-on-one (2 - 3 hrs)
    - To attend weekly XA service with your Small Group (2 hrs)
    - To attend Resource Group weekly (1.5 hrs)
    - To meet with your Resource Group Leader (1 hr)
- Participate in the life of the Chi Alpha ministry
  - Attending and bringing your Small Group to Fall Retreat and Winter Conference.
  - Attending and bringing your Small Group to XA events, as they arise.
  - Attending and bringing your Small Group on missions trips.
- Attend a local church

### What a small group leader needs to have and grow in:

Spirit led: Trusts the Holy Spirit, stays in step with Spirit, evidences the fruit of the Spirit, is eagerly desiring the gifts of the Spirit.

Teachable: Has a desire to learn and grow. Asks good questions. Responds well to correction and advice.

Available: Has the time for people, small group, XA service, XA events, and XA leader events.

Reliable: Is faithful to Jesus first, then XA as an organization and the people in XA. Is Consistent and Trustworthy.

Hungry: Always looking for more to take on. Willing to take on a challenge, self-motivated and diligent.

Humble: Lives for the glory of God, not the praise of people. Lacks ego or concerns about status. Quick to point out team efforts and share credit. Defines success collectively.

Smart: Has Emotional Intelligence; having common sense about interacting with people, good judgement and intuition about group dynamics. Is a Host in conversation, not a guest.
